|--------------------------------|---------------------------------|
| 6 slices rye bread (buttered) | 3 eggs |
| 8 ounces ham | 1 cup milk |
| 1 cup Swiss cheese | 1 Tbsp. mustard |
| 1 cup kraut (rinsed & drained) | 1/2 tsp. salt & 1/4 tsp. pepper |

Cube the rye bread. Cut ham into bite-size pieces. Grate the cheese. Mix all this together with the kraut and place in a greased 9x9 dish.

Combine the eggs, milk, mustard, salt & pepper.

Pour into dish. Mix slightly.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30-35 minutes.

This is almost as good as a reuben sandwich!
