Pre-heat oven to 350 degrees.

Using a 2 quart casseole dish, layer potatoes (sprinkle each layer with salt and pepper), celery, beef, onions, and tomatoes. Garnish with pepper rings.

Cook covered for 1 hour or until vegetables are tender.

BILL'S BARS

Mix (by hand) 1 package chocolate cake mix with 1 egg and 1/3 cup oil, until crumbly. Reserve 1 cup for the topping.

Pat remaining crumb mixture into ungreased 9x13 pan. Bake 15 minutes at 350 degrees. Cool slightly.

Beat 8 oz. cream cheese, 1/3 cup sugar, and 1 egg until fluffy.

Spread over baked layer. Sprinkle with 1 cup chocolate chips and reserved 1 cup crumb mixture.

Bake additional 15 minutes.

RHUBARB CAKE



Grease 9x13 pan.

Spread 2 cups miniature marshmallows over the bottom of the pan.

Mix white cake mix according to directions on box, using whole egg. Pour batter over marshmallows.

Bring 3 cups rhubarb, 1 cup water, and 1 cup sugar to a boil. Add 3 oz. package strawberry Jello. You can pour it either hot or cool over the cake mix.

Bake at 350 degrees for 50 minutes.

Marshmallows will rise to the top and the rhubarb will be on the bottom.
