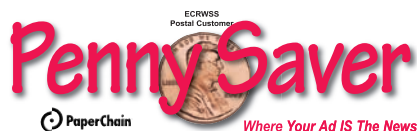

In the last census 3.2 million farmers operated 2.1 million farms. 44% of all farms reported having 2 operators, on the average older, more likely to be male and more likely to consider farming their primary occupation. Of the 2.1 million principal operators in the U.S., 288,264 were women. This was a 6% decrease since 2007, average age was 55 to 64 years, with 75 years and over being one third of that number. Under 25 years was the least.

The majority of the nation's 2.1 million farms are small in terms of sales; 75% sold less than \$50,000 in agricultural products; 57% had sales less than \$10,000.
